CENTRO DESARROLLO TECNOLOGICO INDUSTRIAL- CDTI

Aid for the implementation of strategic research, development and innovation programmes in cooperation, developed by Technological Centres and Innovation Support Centres at the national level, in one of the Cervera priority technologies.

TYPES OF PROJECTS and BENEFICIARIES

Groups of Technological Centres and Innovation Support Centres at the national level registered in the Register of Technological Centres.

The groups must be made up of a minimum of 3 entities and a maximum of 5.

The coordinating entity of the group must be a Technology Centre.

Each centre may submit a maximum of 3 applications (1 as coordinator).

Non-economic R&D activities will be supported in one of Cervera's priority technologies, in a 3-year strategic programme.

Cervera Priority Technologies:

1. Advanced materials
2. Eco-Innovation
3. Smart transportation
4. Energy transition
5. Smart manufacturing
6. Technologies for health
7. Safe and healthy food chain
8. Protection of information
9. Deep learning and Artificial Intelligence
10. Advanced mobile networks

Minimum budget requested: 2,000,000 euros.

The minimum bankable budget will be 1,700,000 euros.

Maximum budget requested: 4,000,000 euros.

Duration: three years as of January 1, 2020.

TYPE OF AID

The aids for this call will consist of grants.

The aid will be calculated as a percentage of the budget of the strategic program up to a maximum of 100%.

The maximum individual amount of each aid per beneficiary group will be 4,000,000 euros.

Each centre may request a maximum grant equivalent to 50% of its total income corresponding to the last closed financial year. In the event that the centre participates in more than one proposal, all the aid requested for the purpose of carrying out this verification will be added. In the event that the aid granted finally exceeds the aforementioned limit, it will be reduced proportionally.

ELIGIBLE EXPENSES

Personal. Hired and newly hired.

Appliances and equipment. Amortization of new and used appliances that are not amortized.

Fungible Material. Supplies and similar products.

Intangible assets acquisition costs.

Industrial and intellectual property rights. Request and other costs derived from their maintenance.

Contract research costs. Knowledge and patents acquired.

Consulting costs. Support and advice on innovation.

Training costs. Of the personnel associated with the performance.

Fees to companies. National and international scientists.

Registration costs. Congresses, seminars, conferences, technical conferences and similar events.

Auditor's report. Limit of € 3,000 per annuity.
